 Dave Nipper, Chair of the By-laws committee, gave a statement on online/virtual meetings, voting etc.  
 Elections were held for the offices of chair and vice chair. The position of chair was vacated by the resignation of McCay Frerichs on April 2. Pat Tucker was nominated for chair by Annette Harker with a second from John Conquergood. Dennis Sutton motioned to close nominations with a second from Todd DeVries. Miranda Marquit motioned to accept by acclamation with a second from John Conquergood. Todd DeVries nominated Parker Hume to fill the newly vacated vice chair position with a second from Mel Fitch. Mel Fitch motioned to close nominations with a second from Todd DeVries. Miranda Marquit motioned to accept by acclamation with a second from Annette Harker.  
 John Conquergood gave the Treasurer's report.  
 Larry LaRocco spoke on the Biden Campaign.  
 Paulette Jordan & Jim Vandermass, candidates in the May 19 Democratic Primary for Senator James Risch's seat, both said a few words.  
 Aaron Swisher, candidate running against Rep. Mike Simpson shared his thoughts. Miranda Marquit and David Roth, candidates running to replace the current House seatholders in D33, spoke as well.  
 Jim DeAngelis spoke about monetary help for other East Idaho candidates. Pat Tucker motioned to discuss \$500 to go to Mike Saville in Bannock County. Jim DeAngelis & Miranda Marquit second. Miranda Marquit proposes an amendment to Jim's motion to offer Travis Ohler of Bingham County, \$500 as well. Dennis Sutton said this all needed to go through the Campaign Committee for vetting.

The Idaho State Democratic Primary will be by absentee ballot only, requested by May 19 and due by June 2.

Most events are pending on date and whether virtual or in person.

Reclaim Idaho had a successful Virtual Gala on April 18, with David Daley as Keynote Speaker. RI is petitioning Governor Little and the Secretary of State to collect signatures online for the Invest in Idaho Initiative due to in person collecting being suspended because of the coronavirus. RI is also assisting Idahoans in signing up for Medicaid Expansion, with those numbers growing due to the statewide Stay at Home Order and the coronavirus.

Elle Casner speaks to the June 2 primary results & the required reorganizing meetings across the state will follow. The IDP virtual convention will be held on June 12-14. Details of the national DNC convention scheduled for August 17-20 are still pending.

Dennis Sutton asks that Carrie Mullen be appointed Precinct 18 Vice Captain. Done.

Lyn Cameron asked that people contact the Mayor and City Council members in support of the public accommodations bill being presented soon.
